Space for innovation

Halton has a supreme location at the centre of the Northwest communications network. Close proximity to both the M62 and M56 corridors, 11 minutes from Liverpool John Lennon Airport and 28 minutes from Manchester International Airport, expansion of the Ditton intermodal terminal and plans for a New River crossing all make Halton a positive draw for business investment.

Halton has an impressive portfolio of existing and potential sites suitable for science and technology businesses. The internationally renowned Daresbury Science & Innovation Campus contains the world-class Daresbury Laboratory alongside the Daresbury Innovation Centre, a science and technology business incubator, home to over 60 tenants.

Also, the Heath Business & Technology Park, Runcorn is a first-class business park, home to over 150 businesses, and offers a range of scientific support and expertise. Other sites such as Daresbury Park, Manor Park, and developments at the Widnes Waterfront mean that there are plenty of high-quality business premises available.

Support for innovation

There is plenty of funding and business support for businesses wishing to innovate and develop their processes and products through research and development. This website can signpost businesses to over 20 grants and award programmes and over 20 sources of loans and investment schemes available to science and technology businesses located in, and wishing to relocate to, Halton.

Workforce support and training
